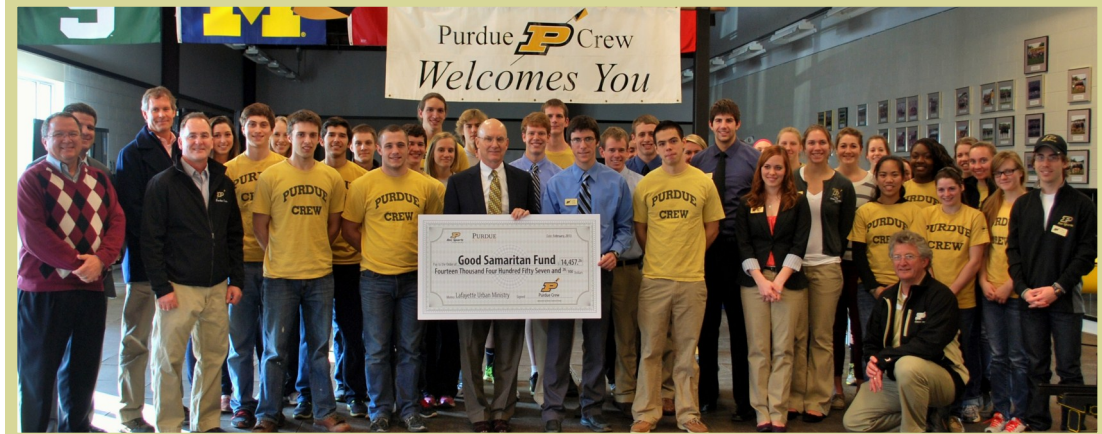


## Update: Row-A-Thon 2013 Purdue Crew donates \$14,457 to LUM

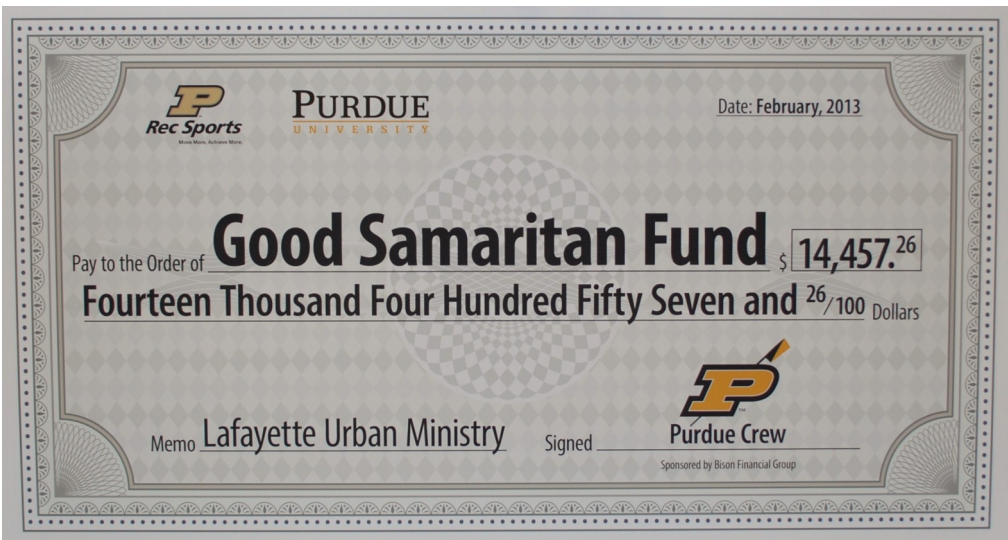


Mayors Tony Roswarski & John Dennis
