LUM Services—One Month Snapshot

For over 40 years, LUM has worked to give back the hope, the future, and the self-respect to low-income people in the Greater Lafayette area.

The new year has been busy for LUM so far. During the first month of 2013, all the LUM services have either matched or exceeded the volume compared to last year.



During the month of January 2013...

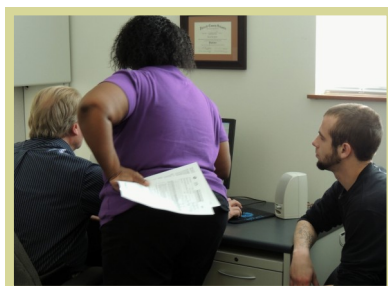
- [Good Samaritan Program](#) served 221 clients
- [Case Management](#) counseled 62 clients
- [St. John's/LUM Food Pantry](#) served 677 families
- [ID Clinic](#) assisted 16 clients
- [Tax Assistance Program](#) filed for 200 households
- [Emergency Shelter](#) reports 1131 bed-nights with 133 new shelter guests

Also, LUM engaged 74 children. In January 2013...

- 29 high school students were enrolled in [Achieve! Stay in School Program](#)
- 45 elementary school students were enrolled in the [After School Program](#)
