Hunger Hike 5K Run—April 20

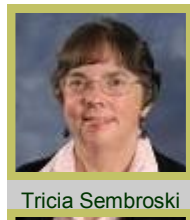
Come join us for the Hunger Hike 5K Run – Race to Feed the Hungry
