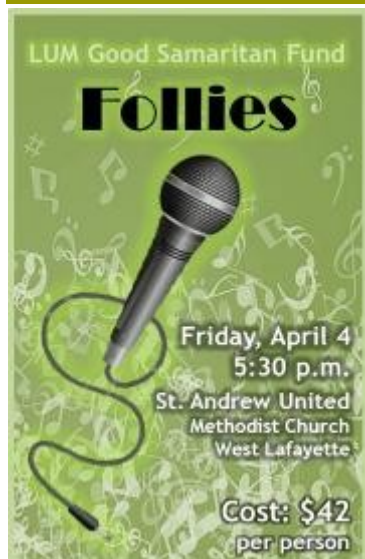

In November 2013, LUM was awarded \$16,887 in Phase 31 Emergency Food and Shelter Program funding. EFSP is a program of the federal government designed to quickly provide emergency relief to those in our nation with critical food and shelter needs. This award has had a tremendous positive impact on LUM's ability to assist families with critical food needs through the LUM [Good Samaritan Fund](#) and to offer emergency housing to individuals in transition at the LUM [Emergency Shelter](#). These funds were especially needed in the early months of 2014 due to the extreme winter weather conditions.

Plots are available this year at Tippecanoe County community gardens. Garden plots are available as follows:

- **Chatham Square Site** - Chatham Square (south-east side) on Greenbush Street, Lafayette
- **Cumberland Park Site** - Kalberer Road just west of Salisbury Street, West Lafayette
- **Extension Field Site** - Tippecanoe County Extension Office on 3150 Sagamore Parkway S near the Mall



Plots are available for an annual fee of \$25 (which may be waived if there is financial need) and measure roughly 15' x 20'. Water, hoses, mulch, straw, and tools are provided.
