Rudy Lopez is on the *Fast for Families* nationwide bus tour (which will end in Washington DC) with a stop in Lafayette/West Lafayette. LUM is assisting Rudy Lopez in meeting with our local elected officials, faith leaders and student leaders from Purdue and Ivy Tech.

Rudy Lopez was one of several immigration reformers who engaged in a 22-day hunger strike on the National Mall in Washington DC last November/December. While fasting, he received visits in his tent from President Obama, Vice President Biden, First Lady Michelle Obama and several members of the US Congress.
