



Update: Gifts that Make a Difference

Anonymous Gifts—Difference Makers

The following five anonymous gifts have been received by LUM during the month of June:



- **\$5,000** from the estate of a recently deceased, long-time friend and supporter of LUM, for the general support of **LUM's programs**.
- A stock gift of **\$5,051** from a valued LUM volunteer. \$420 is designated for three **LUM Camp** Camperships and the remainder to the **LUM Good Samaritan Fund**.
- A gift of **\$10,000** to support the **St. John's/LUM Food Pantry**. The donor is a member of St. Lawrence Roman Catholic Church. The donation was made in honor of Fr. Dan Gartland who has accepted a new assignment after 19 years of service there. Fr. Dan asked parishioners to honor his ministry at St. Lawrence by performing a work of mercy.



- A gift for **\$10,000** given to LUM's **Good Samaritan Fund** by a LUM volunteer and donor. The donor was the beneficiary of an recently settled estate. The gift is to be used to extend Good Samaritan Fund assistance to working individuals above and beyond the fund's usual \$150 per year limit.



Also, a LUM Campaign for the Future pledge payment of **\$100,000** was made by a very special friend of LUM. The payment is funding a **variety of LUM programs** including:

LUM Camp is a 100% scholarship-based camp. LUM Camp only serves children who wouldn't otherwise have the opportunity to experience the benefits of a first class overnight camp program. Please consider sponsoring a LUM camper this year.

Myth: Most immigrants cross the border illegally.



Facts:

Approximately 72% of the foreign born population are authorized immigrants, including naturalized citizens, legal permanent residents, and legal temporary residents. It is estimated that 40-50% of unauthorized resident population were inspected and admitted and chose to stay after their status ended. About 40% to 50% of the unauthorized immigrants living in the US entered with inspection.
