Classes started this week in all Indiana schools — which means the LUM After School Program has started as well.

The LUM After School Program provides safe, fun and enriching childcare for children in afternoon kindergarten through 5th grade. ASP serves up to 54 children for three hours each school day, enabling their parents to finish their workday.

The children are transported from local elementary schools to LUM where they work on homework, have a nutritious snack, and participate in religious education, crafts, music, and other fun and educational activities. In addition, the group goes on numerous field trips.
