



Update: Immigration Clinic Open Grand Opening—LUM Immigration Clinic

On Tuesday, August 19, 2014, Lafayette Urban Ministry officially opened the new Immigration Services Clinic.

The Grand Opening of the new LUM Immigration Services Clinic was hosted by Joe Micon, LUM executive director, and featured remarks from various individuals engaged in immigration work, the unveiling of the Immigration Clinic logo, and a reception with cake, refreshments, and fellowship.



Among the speakers were Timothy Doherty, Bishop, Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana; Jeffrey Newell, President, Tippecanoe Bar Association; Sisters Joan Scheller and Karen Sue Durliat, Guadalupe Center in Huntingburg; Pastor Zach Szmara, Director of the Immigration Clinic, Bridge Christian Church, Logansport; and Trish Maxwell, Executive Director, Lafayette Area Reading Academy.

The LUM Immigration Center then presented information to the Lafayette community with the services provided by the clinic. Remarks were offered by Susan Brouillette, Program Director of the LUM Immigration Service Clinic; Joy Grow, legal advisor to the clinic; and Theresa Cecil, the instructor of the naturalization classes.



Two of the highlights of the events were the unveiling of the Center's logo (pictured below) by artist, Devon Wolfe, student at Lafayette Jefferson High School; and a presentation from Indiana State Representative Sheila Klinker of a proclamation from the Indiana General Assembly commemorating the Grand Opening (picture to the left). The LUM Immigration Clinic will be located in the LUM Office (420 N 4th Street, Lafayette). Consultations will begin by appointment on September 17th. Walk-in hours will be available on Wednesday evenings from 5-7 p.m.

- **Receptionist** - greet clients and answer phones (Wednesdays 5-7 p.m.)
- **Intake specialist** - interviewing clients, data input (Wednesdays 5-7 p.m., flexible hours through the week)
- **Case management** - follow up by phone or email with clients and agencies; collect documents; make sliding scale and fee waiver determinations, and managing files
