LUM encourages you to attend the Indiana Department of Transportation's Naming Ceremony for the new US 231 in honor of the legendary US Olympian, Lafayette native and Purdue alumnus, Ray Ewry. US 231 along the Purdue West Lafayette campus between Martin Jischke Drive and Lindberg Road will officially be known as the **Raymond Clarence Ewry Memorial Parkway**.
