




Update: Many Ways to Get Engaged

As a Volunteer Live-In Shelter Coordinator

The LUM Emergency Shelter has an immediate opening for a Volunteer Live-in Coordinator. The benefits of the Live-in Coordinator include an efficiency apartment, utilities, cable TV, phone, internet, meals, and use of laundry facilities. LUM also offers this volunteer position a \$400 monthly stipend.



The Volunteer Live-in Coordinator is on duty 8:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday; sleeps those nights from 11:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.; and is available for consultation throughout the night. The Volunteer Live-in Coordinator supervises the shelter guests, directs and oversees the work of the shelter volunteers; & is on call 24/7.
